

ABOUT THE FESTIVAL

Renew Fest is an annual festival for full-system regenerative change, based in the heart of the Northern Rivers.

Our aim is to **support full sector transition** to a resilient regenerative culture locally, and be an inspiration for this nationally.

We go **system-wide and system-deep** — linking all sectors involved in ecological, economic and social renewal, and interweaving our inner hearts with outer actions.

The festival is held across Mothers' Day Weekend in May, on Arakwal country in Mullumbimby near Byron Bay.

Each year, Renew Fest brings together dozens of organisations and businesses, over one hundred presenters, and up to two thousand participants, to share their ideas, inspirations and longings for everything involved in regenerative change.

It's a space to connect to the grief, joy and creative energy we all have for **living in a better relationship** with the earth and one another, in a time of great environmental crisis and social disconnection.

WHO WE ARE

The festival is led by a core team of local community change makers, amongst them are activists, artists and designers, philosopher, economist, accountant, and a food entrepreneur. As the festival approaches, we are joined by around 100 volunteers.

Renew Fest couldn't come at a better time. It provides a meeting place for those who want to discuss and shape a new story for humanity and how we interact with all living systems.

- New projects, action groups and collaborations are formed and supported.
- Eco tourists are attracted to the Northern Rivers and create strong, intimate links with locals.
- Other festivals, large events and regions are inspired by our sustainability and program innovations.
- Future community projects are funded via a dedicated proportion of any festival surplus (our Renew Community Fund).
- Community resilience grows due to all of this.


The festival is programmed around **three main formats**, combining the best of ideas festivals, practical education and community arts experiences:

Renew Fest is located at Mullumbimby Showground, 20 minutes inland from Byron Bay, on Arakwal Country. Camping is available.

Mullumbimby, known as "the biggest little town in Australia", is the civic heartland of the Northern Rivers, the headquarters of Byron Shire Council, and a site of many community groups and actions.

The township is at the epicentre of the larger populations of Lismore/Nimbin (west), Gold Coast (north) and Byron/Ballina (south).

The festival itself is set within the Fig Tree Grove of Mullumbimby Showground, a gorgeous shaded area with birds, trees and sense of connection to wild earth, but only 5 minutes from the town centre.

TIMING

Renew Fest runs across Mothers' Day Weekend, the second weekend in May, during the beautiful time of late autumn.

We celebrate Mothers' Day as a time for honouring our connection to Mother Earth, to all our mothers, and indeed all the generative well-springs of life.

HISTORY

2014-2015: Proto-festivals activating community

After returning from the success of the **Bentley Blockade**, our festival director Ella Rose Goninan was inspired to funnel the energy into regenerative solutions 'back in town'. She ran two **100% Sustainable Mullumbimby** town meetings, which brought hundreds together across many sectors and **helped birth various local groups** including COREM and Kindred Youth.

2016-2018: The first three festivals

Our inaugural festival in 2016 was just one day, but made a big impact as the **first festival in Australia to go fully zero waste**, influencing dozens of festivals since then. We grew to two days and three nights by 2018, and became known for **adding humanity renewal** to the sustainability agenda, and for **captivating embodied immersions** like the fig tree soundscape and hourly one-minute-silences.

2019: Deepening into grief and renewal

With ecological grief continuing to increase across our community, and our director Ella experiencing several major grief events of her own, we hosted a special **30hr immersive Vigil For Grief**, to honour our deep connections and disconnections to earth, life and self — accompanied by internationally acclaimed griefwalker Stephen Jenkinson.

2020: Crowdfunding success, then COVID-19

To accelerate the festival's growth, and evolve to a sustainable organisation model with a paid core team, we held a very successful **crowdfunding ticket blitz**. However, with COVID-19, we needed to postpone the festival until May 2021.



2020 CROWDFUNDING SUCCESS!

In mid February 2020, a flock of 'visionary early birds' came together to ensure the festival could go ahead.

It was a tremendous success and an energising outpouring of collective action and communal love for the festival and for regenerative change.
